



1. At least one of the campus governance groups on each campus should be “inclusive.” This group is the primary “connection” to the college-wide councils.
  2. Each campus will determine a method for electing or otherwise determining who will represent the campus on each of the College Councils.
  3. The two college-wide councils will develop and maintain a page in the *Powerline*.
  4. The two college-wide councils will develop and publish council by-laws, that make it one of the council chair’s and vice chair’s responsibilities to communicate either personally or through members of the councils with the “primary” campus governance body.
  5. The two college-wide governance bodies should publish their calendars in the *Powerline*.
